The Alternative Dispute Resolution Institute of Manitoba (“ADRIM”) is an affiliate of the Alternative Dispute Resolution Institute of Canada (“ADRIC”). ADRIC is a national, non-profit organization that provides leadership in the development and promotion of dispute resolution services in Canada. ADRIM provides a variety of tools and services, including national accreditation for mediators and arbitrators, unified standards of practice for mediators, and learning and networking opportunities for alternative dispute resolution practitioners.

ADRIM is looking to increase awareness of Conflict Resolution Day, which is an annual recognition day that will take place October 15, 2020. Conflict Resolution Day was started in 2005 by the Association for Conflict Resolution in the United States. Conflict Resolution Day is now recognized around the world on the third Thursday in October each year. It acknowledges and promotes the use of conflict resolution in various areas of society including government, the legal system, business, and communities. Conflict Resolution Day also recognizes organizations that contribute to resolving conflict in a peaceful manner. It is the hope of ADRIM and its membership that Conflict Resolution Day will soon be officially recognized in Manitoba.

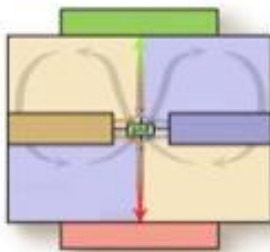
